Step 2: Turn in Required Items

- In order to have your ID card ready for you by move-in (which gives you access to your building, room, & dining hall), you **MUST** submit a photo [HERE](#) by **Friday, July 28!**

- All you need to do is submit a photo using the link above. Do NOT pick up your ID.
- If you already have a campus ID, please bring it with you to on Move-In Day.
- Complete the Personal Evacuation Plan on the Housing Portal (located in the header once you log in).
- Make sure you have provided your immunization records to [Student Health Services](#).

Step 3: Plan Ahead!

- Review the [Move-In Website](#), which includes information about move-in, a printable packing list, a map for parking and instructions for checking in on Move-In Days, as well as [community standards](#) (so that you don't pack prohibited items!) & general information about University Housing.
- Communicate with your roommate(s) to prepare for moving in. To do so:
 - Log on to the Housing Portal and select "Housing Application".
 - Navigate to the "Housing Status" page.
 - Scroll down to see your roommate(s) screen name and click on "send message."
 - For a faster response, share your own contact information.
- Download the **Microsoft Teams** app using your university email. The Housing staff will be utilizing Microsoft Teams throughout the year to share important updates and information. Microsoft Teams download links: [desktop](#), [iPhone](#), [Android](#).

Step 4: Move In!

- Upon arrival, you should park and leave your belongings in your car. Be prepared to present identification & your student ID number.
 - You will receive your student ID card if you have not lived in housing previously.
 - To check in, go to the common area of your assigned building: Pacific Hall

Step 5: Beach Days

- Participation in the [Beach Days](#) program on August 18-21 is required. More communication to come about the schedule and required Beach Days modules.
